12.4 Mission and Outreach

12.4.1. Pinnaroo Support - Milton Hender prayed then thanked Adare for supporting Wendy & him. Geranium, (vital Christian youth club), Pinnaroo (ageing) Karoonda (active congregation) All have lost their youth to further study or work outside the area.

In the past, the church didn't involve/care for the general population. Now need to reach out and support the local community whether or not they attend church. Major work and mission for the week by the key people in small churches is preparing for Sunday worship with no time/energy to get out into the community. Money (with very low funds) has come before mission

Milton has shared resources such as Project Reconnect DVDs, Adare DVDs, internet sites, to ease the burden for the church folk.

Milton & Wendy encourage church folk to follow up community needs 'discovered' when attending other community activities e.g. bowls, over 50s etc Possible answers: Synod – patrol padre with regular visits.

Adare has been providing a preacher to Pinnaroo once per month - relieves Stephanie. Rev Darren Lovell visits Karoonda and Geranium.

Adare has a covenant with Pinnaroo. **Agreed** we continue to provide preachers monthly. (to be reviewed annually.)

Each church is doing a Mission Plan to work out their purpose. The churches are trying to do something about their situation.

Mission planning meeting at 1:30pm on 25 Feb with Darren Lovell at Pinnaroo. Milton and Wendy attending as Adare reps.

Another rep from Adare would be good. See if Pip Burfield able to attend. Services now at 11:00am

Peter Manuel still happy to coordinate. Encourage Home groups to take a turn. Provide complete list of Pinnaroo's music to preachers.

Agreed, we admire Milton & Wendy's passion for folk in the Mallee.
