## ANNUAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING 25th NOVEMBER.

ANNUAL REPORTS are due for the Congregational AGM on 25th November. Please provide a typewritten report to Secretary, Anne Craig not later than the 4th November for inclusions with other relevant documents.

**COMMITMENT:** A number of positive decisions were made by the congregation at the General meeting of the Congregation on 7th October. Among other things we agreed that we would seek a full time Minister in 2019, but to achieve this we need to increase the giving by at least \$400/week. We would also like to maintain office services and our church outreach programs. All members of the congregation are therefore encouraged to look at their giving to see if perhaps they can increase their contribution. We also hope that those who have chosen to cease their contribution will reconsider, as withdrawing finances puts Adare at risk. We will review the situation again at the AGM as we can not continue with a predicted \$20,000 shortfall in relation to our budget.

## DEAR WORLD T2 /2870 JK ROWLING

A story of love and courage amid brutality and terror, this is the testimony of a child who has endured the unthinkable.



When eight-year old Bana Alabed took to twitter to describe the horrors she and her family were experiencing in war - torn Syria, her heart rending messages touched the world and gave a voice to millions of innocent children. Bana's happy childhood was abruptly upended by civil war when she was only three years old.

Over the next four years, she new nothing but bombing, destruction and fear. Her harrowing ordeal culminated in a brutal siege where she, her parents and her two brothers were trapped in Aleppo with little access to food, water, medicine or other necessities.

Facing death as bombs relentlessly fell around them, one of which completely destroyed their home, Bana and her family embarked on a perilous escape to Turkey. Bana has lost her best friend, her school, her home and her homeland. But she has not lost her hope - for herself and for other children around the world who are victims and refugees of war and deserve better lives.

DEAR WORLD is a powerful reminder of the resilience of human spirit, and the unconquerable courage of a child and the abiding power of hope.
