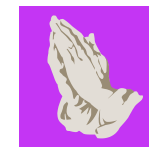

COMMITMENT: A number of positive decisions were made by the congregation at the General meeting of the Congregation on 7th October. Among other things we agreed that we would seek a full time Minister in 2019, but to achieve this we need to increase the giving by at least \$400/week. We would also like to maintain office services and our church outreach programs. All members of the congregation are therefore encouraged to look at their giving to see if perhaps they can increase their contribution. We also hope that those who have chosen to cease their contribution will reconsider, as withdrawing finances puts Adare at risk. We will review the situation again at the AGM as we can not continue with a predicted \$20,000 shortfall in relation to our budget.
